What Is Ambien?

Ambien contains zolpidem, a medication belonging to a class of medicines called sedative-hypnotics. It affects activity in the brain to help promote sleep.

Healthcare professionals may prescribe zolpidem for people experiencing difficulty falling asleep. The medication is generally intended for use according to a doctor's instructions and should not be taken in larger amounts or more frequently than prescribed.



How Does Zolpidem Work?

Zolpidem works on certain chemical signaling pathways in the brain that are involved in sleep. Its effects can make it easier for some people to fall asleep.

Because the response to zolpidem can vary between individuals, the prescribed dose and treatment duration should be determined by a healthcare professional.

Common Ambien Strengths

Zolpidem may be available in different strengths and formulations. The appropriate strength depends on the individual's circumstances and the prescription provided by their healthcare professional.

Discuss Sleep Problems With a Healthcare Professional

Persistent insomnia can have many possible causes. A healthcare professional can discuss your sleep symptoms, existing conditions,

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Never change your prescribed zolpidem dose without speaking with your healthcare professional.

Important Ambien Safety Information

Zolpidem should be taken exactly as prescribed. Several precautions are especially important when using this medication.

Take Only as Directed

Follow the prescribed dosage and instructions. Do not take more zolpidem than directed.

Allow Enough Time for Sleep

Zolpidem is generally taken immediately before going to bed when the person can remain in bed for a full night's sleep.

Avoid Alcohol

Alcohol can increase the sedating effects of zolpidem and may

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Discuss Other Medicines

Tell your healthcare professional about prescription medicines, over-the-counter products, and supplements you use.

Complex Sleep Behaviors

One of the important safety concerns associated with zolpidem is the possibility of complex sleep behaviors. These can include activities performed while not fully awake.

Examples may include sleepwalking, preparing or eating food, making phone calls, or other activities performed with limited awareness.

If a person experiences unusual behavior while asleep after taking zolpidem, they should contact their healthcare professional promptly.

Possible Side Effects

Like other prescription medicines, zolpidem can cause side effects. Some may be mild, while others can require medical attention.

Seek medical attention if you experience severe, unusual, or rapidly worsening symptoms.

Ambien and Other Medicines

Some medicines can increase the sedating effects of zolpidem. This is particularly important when other medicines that affect the central nervous system are being used.

Before taking zolpidem, provide your healthcare professional with a complete list of your current medications and supplements.



Healthy Sleep Habits

Medication is only one part of managing sleep difficulties. Healthy sleep habits may also support better sleep quality.

Keep a Consistent Schedule

Try to maintain consistent sleeping and waking times, including on weekends.

Create a Comfortable Bedroom

Keep your sleeping environment comfortable, quiet, and suitable for rest.



Limiting bright screens before bedtime may help create a calmer transition toward sleep.

Limit Stimulants

Caffeine and other stimulants later in the day may interfere with sleep for some people.

A Different Role in Medication Care

Oxycodone and Ambien are not interchangeable medicines. Oxycodone is associated with pain management, while Ambien (zolpidem) is used for certain sleep-related problems. Their different purposes are important when reviewing a complete medication profile.

Central Nervous System Effects

Oxycodone can affect the central nervous system and may produce drowsiness or reduced alertness. This is one reason healthcare professionals consider a person's other medicines before treatment.
