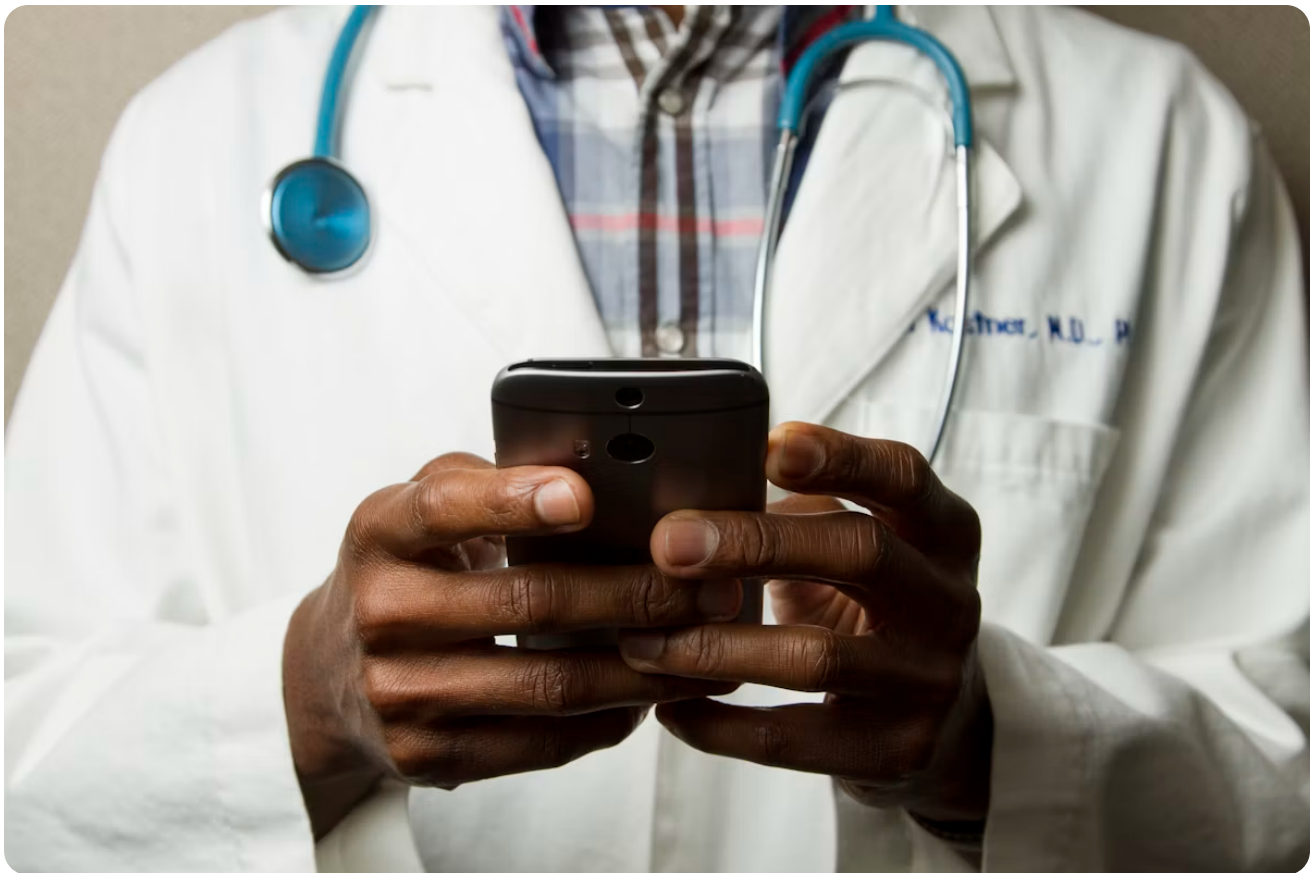

Understanding Oxycodone

Oxycodone belongs to a class of medicines known as opioids. Opioids can change how the brain and nervous system respond to pain. They can also cause drowsiness, dizziness, nausea, constipation, physical dependence, and other adverse effects. In some situations, oxycodone can cause dangerously slow breathing.

For this reason, a prescription opioid should not be shared with another person or taken in a larger amount or more frequently than prescribed.

Understanding Acetaminophen

Acetaminophen is the second active ingredient in this combination. Checking the labels of other medicines is important because acetaminophen may appear in multiple products. Taking excessive amounts can cause serious liver injury.

Important Safety Information

Oxycodone can cause significant drowsiness and slow breathing. Combining opioids with alcohol, sedatives, or other substances that depress the central nervous system can increase the risk of severe sedation and dangerous breathing problems.

Very slow or difficult breathing, unusual difficulty staying awake, or an inability to wake someone can indicate a medical emergency. Seek emergency medical assistance immediately if these symptoms occur.

Turning the Conversation Toward Safer Pain Care

Good pain care begins with an open conversation. Patients can explain how pain affects sleep, movement work mood and everyday activities. This information can help a healthcare

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Discuss Your Pain

Explain where the pain occurs, how long it has lasted, what makes it better or worse, and how it affects your normal activities.

Review Your Medicines

Tell your doctor or pharmacist about prescription medicines, nonprescription medicines, supplements, and other substances you use.

Ask About Safety

Ask about possible side effects, interactions, safe storage, and what to do if you accidentally take too much.

Questions to Ask a Healthcare Professional

If oxycodone/acetaminophen has been prescribed, useful questions include: What is the medication intended to treat? How should it be taken? What side effects should be monitored? Which medicines or substances should be avoided? How should unused medication be stored or disposed of?

Patients who prefer Spanish can ask their healthcare professional or pharmacist to explain medication instructions in Spanish. Clear communication can make treatment instructions and safety precautions easier to understand.

Pain Management Can Be Individualized

There is no single approach that works for every type of pain. The cause of the pain, its severity and duration, other health conditions, current medications, and individual circumstances can all influence treatment decisions.

Safe Medication Habits

Keep prescription medicines in a secure location and follow the instructions provided with the prescription. Do not give prescription opioids to someone else, even if that person appears to have similar symptoms. If medication is no longer needed, ask a pharmacist or healthcare professional about an appropriate disposal method.

A Better Pain-Care Conversation

Asking questions is an important part of safer care. A patient does not have to manage persistent or severe pain without support. Discussing symptoms, treatment goals, possible risks, and alternatives with a qualified healthcare professional can help create a more informed approach to pain management.

Understanding Oxycodone in Prescription Pain Management



Oxycodone is a prescription opioid medication that may be used by healthcare professionals to manage certain types of moderate to severe pain. Because opioids can affect the central nervous system, treatment should be based on an individual's medical needs and followed exactly as prescribed.

Pain management is more than simply reducing discomfort. A healthcare professional may consider the cause and severity of pain, other medications, medical history, and possible non-opioid treatment options when developing an appropriate treatment plan.

Responsible Use and Important Safety Considerations

Prescription opioids require careful use because they can cause drowsiness, constipation,

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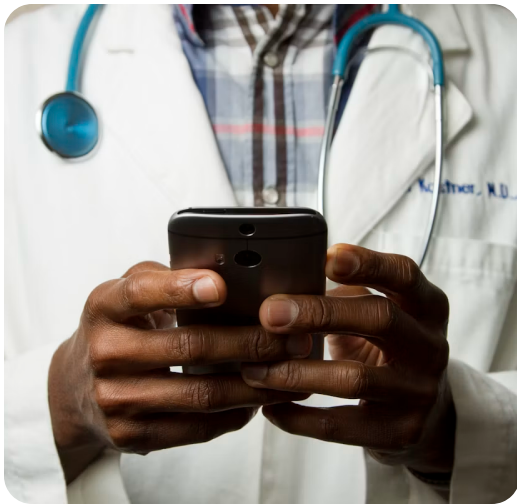


other substances can increase the risk of serious harm.

Patients should discuss their complete medication list with their healthcare professional and should never share prescription opioid medication with another person. Medication should also be stored securely and disposed of according to appropriate local guidance.



A Balanced Approach to Pain Care



Effective pain care can involve several approaches depending on the underlying condition. Physical therapy, rehabilitation, non-opioid medicines, lifestyle measures, and other treatments may sometimes be considered alongside or instead of opioid therapy.

Anyone taking a prescription opioid should speak with a qualified healthcare professional about expected benefits, possible side effects, duration of treatment, and warning signs that require urgent medical attention. Never change the dose or stop a prescription suddenly without professional guidance.



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
